## **NOTICE OF OFFICES TO BE VOTED FOR AT THE STATE GENERAL ELECTION**

The following is the notice of county, federal and state offices that will be voted for at the state general election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The filing period begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 17, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 31, 2022.

Note: Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 30, 2022 in observance of Memorial Day.

The place of filing for federal offices is the Office of the Secretary of State, State Office Building, Room 180, 100 Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., St. Paul, MN 55155-1299. The place of filing for state offices is with the Office of the Secretary of State or with the County Auditor of the county in which the candidate resides.

The place of filing for Becker County offices is the Auditor-Treasurer, Original Courthouse, 915 Lake Avenue, Detroit Lakes, MN 56501-3403.

Candidates may file in person or by mail. Candidates who will be absent from the state during the filing period and meet the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 204B.09, subdivision 1a, may arrange to file, in person, prior to departure.
