RECYCLABLES ACCEPTED IN CART

PAPER

- Mail, office, and school papers
- Magazines & newspaper inserts
- Phone books
- Soft cover books
- Cereal & pop type boxes
- Shredded paper in sealed paper bags

CARTONS: (Rinse containers)

Milk, soup, broth, wine, and juice cartons/boxes

METAL (Rinse containers)

- Food and beverage cans
- Aluminum foil and trays
- Pie tins/ decorative tins

NO: No food waste contamination

CARDBOARD

- Any corrugated cardboard packaging

PLASTIC #1- #7 (Rinse and leave caps on)

Bottles and Jugs:

- Water, pop, & juice bottles
- Milk & juice jugs
- Ketchup & salad dressing bottles
- Dishwashing/detergent jugs
- Shampoo, soap, & lotion bottles

Cups & containers:






- Yogurt, pudding, & fruit cups
- Disposable cups/bowls
- Margarine, cottage cheese, & other containers
- Produce, deli, & takeout containers

GLASS

Food type containers

Please take glass to public recycling sites/Big Blue Bins

Directions for Cart Use:

-  Bins must be set out with trash
-  Bin placed curbside, opening should face the street (handle side toward house)
-  Bin must be 3 feet from any object
-  Bring glass to public 'big blue bin' locations.
-  Clean and empty containers only



-  NO Needles/sharps
-  NO Food Waste
-  NO Garbage
-  NO Styrofoam
-  NO Plastic bags
-  NO Scrap metal
