## **BECKER COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE OFFICE IS NOW ACCEPTING LIMITED VEHICLE APPLICATIONS**

**Detroit Lakes, MN**– Becker County Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will be accepting limited drop box services for its customers. This is done in accordance with Governor Walz’s Emergency Executive Order 20-20 “Directing Minnesotans to Stay at Home”. The drop box is in the main lobby of the Becker County Courthouse at 915 Lake Avenue, Detroit Lakes, MN from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

The DMV will accept the following transactions: Registration Renewals, DNR Renewals, Dealer Work and Title Transfers. For Prorate Services **only**, call 218-846-7308 to schedule an appointment.

On March 28, 2020, the State of Minnesota passed legislation that provides an extension for Minnesotans whose driver's licenses or ID cards expire during the peacetime emergency. The law extends the expiration date for any valid driver's license, instruction permit, provisional license, operator's permit, limited license, and farm work license that would expire during the peacetime emergency. The expiration dates for these licenses will be extended for two months after the month the peacetime emergency ends. The peacetime emergency is set to expire May 13, 2020. Therefore, the expiration date will now be July 13, 2020 unless otherwise extended by Executive Order.
